Grifols will disclose any fees and/or expenses provided to covered recipients in accordance with applicable federal and state laws.

In accordance with the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) Code on Interactions with Healthcare Professionals, attendance at this educational program is limited to healthcare professionals. Accordingly, attendance by guests or spouses cannot be accommodated.

Minnesota healthcare practitioners are limited by government regulations to a \$50 "gift" cap per year. Any potential overage must be disclosed to the state of Minnesota by Grifols.

Vermont healthcare practitioners are prohibited by government regulations from receiving "anything of value" (including food) from medical device, pharmaceutical, and biological manufacturers. Any violation must be disclosed to the state of Vermont by Grifols.

Federal employees are prohibited by government regulations from receiving gifts (including meals) valued in excess of \$20 on any occasion and more than \$50 in a calendar year from any single contractor, except in connection with "widely attended gatherings" or incident to a society or membership unrelated to their government employment. In order to ensure compliance with these regulations, federal employees must pre-register for this program if the program is not in conjunction with a society meeting.
